The Canyon View Elders are excited to announce our **Fall Sunday Worship schedule**, which includes Bible classes for all ages. This plan provides more options for members to select from, considering the restrictions you are willing to follow. Each worship has different safety benefits, and each has protocols to protect others and to allow a measure of peace and protection to our vulnerable. Please choose a worship venue with which you are comfortable.

From 9/20/20 through 10/25/20, Canyon View will offer four ways to worship and Bible classes for all ages on Sunday mornings.

## Bible Classes and Worship

We will be having class time for all ages at 9:00 AM. Children will remain in the 10:00 AM service with their parents and are invited to worship with us while we sing and pray. Activity bags will be in the lobby, complete with a snack. Please save your activity bag for use during the sermon. Bags can be returned to the tub marked "used" in the lobby.

- **Room 3:** Ages birth through 2 years.
- **Rooms 1 & 2:** Ages 3 years to 5<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Teens will meet near the building with Paul & Arlene Ashton.
- Adults will meet in the courtyard.

## Facebook Online Worship

This service begins Sunday mornings at 10:00 AM, but it can be viewed any time or day after that from anywhere you go. Some of you may invite friends or other members to watch in the safety of your home so you can commune together. No protocols are required.

## Drive-in Worship

This service is in the parking lot nearest the courtyard. You will see the preacher, song leader, and prayer leader on a stage behind the picket fence. You can tune your radio to 103.9 FM to listen and sing along. You can roll down your window and talk to friends without a mask as long as you have one full car space between you. You must wear a mask anytime and anywhere outside of the car. Do not touch anyone who is outside of your immediate family in any way. Sorry, not even elbow bumps. Pick up the communion and song list with instructions as you drive up. You can get out of the car to use the courtyard restroom if you pass a health screening first and use hand sanitizer. One person at a time will be permitted (or one person assisting a child) in the men's restroom. Two people at a time will be permitted in the women's restroom. If you enter the restroom and it is already at capacity, please wait in line outside the door.

### Courtyard Worship

There is seating in the shade and in the sun. The seating (spread 10 feet apart) offers more than adequate protection. Everyone must wear a mask at all times when not seated. You can remove your mask while seated. When the service ends, remain seated until your row is instructed to exit. Each family can share a bench. You can add only one chair next to your bench if you need more space. Ensure the aisles are not restricted by more than one chair per bench. You must answer the health screening questions and have your temperature taken at the screening station near the office before entry. Then, use hand sanitizer, pick up the communion and song list with instructions, and find a seat. Do not touch anyone who is outside of your immediate family in any way. Sorry, not even elbow bumps. You can use the courtyard restrooms only. One person at a time will be permitted (or one person assisting a child) in the men's restroom. Two people at a time will be permitted in the women's restroom. If you enter the restroom and it is already at capacity, please wait in line outside the door.

### Auditorium Worship

This service is similar to before the COVID-19 pandemic with the following exceptions. **Everyone must wear a mask at all times even while singing.** There should be plenty of room for all families to have their own rows. However, if more than one family unit must share a row, there should be a minimum of 6 feet (3 chairs) between the two groups. You must answer the health screening questions and have your temperature taken at the health screening station outside the foyer before entry. Then pick up the communion, and song list with instructions and find a seat. Hand sanitizer is available. Do not touch anyone who is outside of your immediate family in any way. Sorry, not even elbow bumps. You can use the indoor restrooms only. One person at a time will be permitted (or one person assisting a child) in the men's restroom. Two people at a time will be permitted in the women's restroom. If you enter the restroom and it is already at capacity, please wait in line outside the door.

### HEALTH SCREENING QUESTIONS

**You must answer all of the health screening questions below before you are eligible for a temperature check. If you are not a member, we also need your name, address, email address, cell and home phone numbers. Just fill out a visitor card. We will not share any information unless someone near you later tests positive.**

- To maintain safety guidelines, please review the following questions. If you answer "yes," please stay at home and get well.
  - Have you visited any COVID-19 hotspots in the **past 14 days**?
  - Have you been exposed to others with a known diagnosis of COVID-19 in the **past 14 days**?
  - Within the **last week** have you experienced:
    - fever of 100°F or more?
    - shortness of breath?
    - dry cough?
    - chills?
    - sore throat?
    - loss of taste or smell?
    - diarrhea?

**PROCEDURES**

- **Lord's Supper** – We will not be passing the communion trays. Individual-serving communion cups will be available on entry.
  
- **Giving** – We will not be passing trays.
  1. There will be a box placed at the back of the auditorium where you may leave your offering.
  2. Also, online giving is a secure and easy way to give. If you need assistance, please call the office at 858-273-5140 and Estella will walk you through the process.
  
- The church staff is on site from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday.
  1. Feel free to call, email, or text us with prayer requests, etc.
  2. The office doors will remain locked during business hours.
  3. If you need to come to the office for any reason, please call Estella ahead of time at the office number, **858-273-5140**. Be sure to wear your face mask. You must pass the health screening questions and temperature check before entering.

**DO NOT COME TO THE BUILDING DURING THE WEEK OR ON SUNDAY if you have a fever, cough, shortness of breath or trouble breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, and/or new loss of taste or smell.**
